Spotlight Performing Arts prides itself on being a happy learning environment with enjoyment and education being the root of all our classes. This policy exists to maintain this environment and enable pupils to reach their full potential.

Disruptive behaviour in the Studio will not be tolerated; class teachers reserve the right to ask pupils to leave the class at any time, if they feel that their behaviour is disturbing the enjoyment and education of other pupils. If a member of staff feels that the behaviour of an individual is continuously disruptive, the management will be informed and the pupil may be asked to leave the Studio. We ask everyone to respect the Staff as well as their fellow pupils.

Regular attendance is essential for progression of individuals. It is also vital that pupils arrive in good time and are ready to commence classes at the correct starting time. Please notify the studio if your child is to be absent. If pupils are absent with no given reason on five or more occasions their placement will be revised and they may be asked to leave. There are No concessions or deductions for classes not attended.

Behaviour in unsupervised areas e.g. changing areas and toilets, must be acceptable and in line with the studios behaviour policy. Changing areas are checked on a regular basis and must be respected by all pupils; please deposit any litter in the bins provided. The management accepts no responsibility for damage or loss of belongings.

All pupils must wear the **correct uniform** for class. Staff at the Dance Studio will advise anyone who is uncertain about what to wear.
